Good Neighbors exists to make the world a place without hunger, where people live together in harmony.





We help families achieve financial stability and long-term resilience by providing initial support, sustainable practices, and economic maintenance.




## Humanitarian Aid (Emergency Aid)

## Empowering Vietnamese Students Through Digital Education

Good Neighbors USA recognizes the growing importance of Information Technology (IT) skills—not only for today’s education but also for future careers. In Vietnam, despite the government’s strong commitment to integrating IT into the national curriculum, many students still lack access to proper computer labs, trained teachers, and foundational IT skills.

In the Good Neighbors Vinh Loc Community Development Project (CDP), six secondary schools serving 2,127 students faced serious challenges, ranging from outdated equipment to limited resources.

These challenges include a shortage of trained IT teachers, inadequate computer facilities, and limited access to equipment. As a result, many students complete secondary school without basic IT skills, placing them at a disadvantage in an increasingly technology-driven world.

To make matters worse, the rise in mobile phone usage introduces new risks, such as online bullying and exposure to harmful content. To address these issues, Good Neighbors USA launched a hands-on IT education initiative aimed at equipping students with the skills and knowledge they need to stay safe and succeed in the digital age.

Nourishing Hope Through School Feeding Program in Tigray

## Tigray, Ethiopia

The lasting effects of political conflict and drought have severely impacted children in Ethiopia's Enderta district, located in the Tigray region. Many students face food insecurity, which affects not only their health but also their ability to focus and perform in school. As a result, education has been significantly disrupted, leading to high dropout rates and major learning gaps.

To address these challenges, Good Neighbors USA launched a student feeding project aimed at improving both school attendance and nutrition.


Through continued efforts and strong community partnerships, we remain committed to addressing both the nutritional and educational needs in Tigray.

# Water & Sanitation

At Good Neighbors USA, we believe that access to clean water and sanitation is a fundamental human right—not a privilege. Without it, people of all ages face preventable illnesses, lost opportunities, and long-term health risks. That’s why we invest in sustainable Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH) solutions that benefit entire communities. Through our WASH programs, we’re working toward a world where no child is left to suffer from contaminated water—and where every individual can thrive in health, safety, and dignity.



 **Gounou Bangou, Niger**

The primary goals of the Fada Tondobon project in the Gonou Bangou Community Development Project (CDP) of Niger were simple yet essential: to provide clean, drinkable water for children and community members, and to promote improved hygiene and sanitation practices within the village.

*"Access to safe drinking water is a basic human need. Through this project, we aimed to ensure that children and families in the region no longer have to rely on unsafe water sources that could lead to illness."*

To support the long-term sustainability of the project, we collaborated with the Municipality and the District Department of Health Affairs (DDHA) in Niger to establish a WASH committee responsible for ongoing monitoring and quality control.

In addition, Good Neighbors USA installed a solar-powered water system, which includes a water tower with a tank and six strategically placed taps for easy access throughout the community.

Through the Good WASH Project, Good Neighbors USA has significantly improved access to clean water and promoted better hygiene in the communities of Gounou Bangou and Fada Tondobon.



 **Rufunsa District, Zambia**

The cholera outbreak that began in October 2023 and escalated in 2024 triggered a severe public health crisis in Zambia. The disease spread rapidly across the country, including areas where our community development projects are located, with Rufunsa District being the most heavily affected. A total of 950 cholera cases were reported across all five CDPs, resulting in the deaths of more than 25 people.

*“Thanks to your generous support, we were able to construct wells in Kapelabulungu Village and Mukunku Village, bringing clean, safe water to over 1,500 people. Before the wells were built, families—especially children—had to walk long distances each day just to collect water. This daily burden not only impacted their health but also kept many children out of school.*

Empowering Youth in El Salvador: Skills for a Brighter Future

## Ahuachapán, El Salvador

In response to rising youth unemployment, widening skill gaps, and the risks of irregular migration, Good Neighbors USA, in partnership with Good Neighbors El Salvador, launched a transformative project in Ahuachapán for 24 vulnerable young people aged 18 to 29. The initiative equipped participants with the skills and confidence needed to build meaningful livelihoods within their own communities. Carried out in collaboration with the U.S. Embassy in El Salvador, the project underscores the power of strong partnerships with local governments and a shared commitment to empowering communities from within.

# Gifts-In-Kind

Good Neighbors USA provides essential items such as medicine, food, school supplies, and clothing to children and residents in need around the world. Through partnerships and networks with related organizations, Good Neighbors USA carries out specialized Gift-In-Kind (GIK) support programs.

Through strong partnerships with corporate donors and local businesses, we delivered new clothing, household items, hygiene products, and educational materials to alleviate hardship and bring hope. By transforming surplus goods into meaningful support, the GIK program reduces waste and strengthens our commitment to sustainable, responsible giving worldwide.

## Lilongwe, Malawi

In 2024, Good Neighbors USA's Gift-In-Kind (GIK) program distributed **\$10,157,601** worth of donated goods internationally and **\$75,000** worth domestically, reaching vulnerable families and communities in need.

In collaboration with Good Neighbors Malawi, the Ministry of Health in Kasungu District, and the Ministry of Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene in Lilongwe, we provided 6,496 bottles of medicine and 3,149,800 Aquatabs. This support strengthened community health services and improved access to safe water and sanitation for vulnerable families.

*"In our village, getting medicine used to mean traveling for hours—sometimes with no guarantee of finding any. When the health teams came and brought what we needed, it was more than just supplies—it was a sign that we hadn't been forgotten. It gave us strength, dignity, and hope to keep going."*



# Humanitarian Aid

At Good Neighbors USA, we are committed to providing emergency relief to communities affected by natural disasters, conflict, and other crises. We recognize the profound and often lasting impact these emergencies have on individuals and families, and we respond swiftly to deliver life-saving assistance—including food, clean water, shelter, and medical care—to those most in need.



Creating a Safe Refuge for Displaced Children and Families



Our humanitarian efforts go beyond immediate relief. We focus on long-term recovery to help communities rebuild and regain stability.

This includes providing psychosocial support for those coping with trauma, implementing community resilience programs to strengthen local capacity, and leading rebuilding initiatives that restore homes, schools, and essential infrastructure.

## Valparaíso, Chile

In 2024, a catastrophic wildfire storm struck Viña del Mar and surrounding areas in Region Valparaíso, Chile, resulting in hundreds of deaths and the destruction of thousands of homes.

In response to the emergency, GN Chile mobilized swiftly along four key action lines: provision of food, clean water, shelter, and emergency medical care.

*"I saw the fire rising from my backyard and grabbed everything I could carry in my two hands. I woke up my children, and we ran out of the house. Our neighbor, who graciously picked up others in his truck, came and rescued us too. From a distance, I watched my home burn to the ground. **I was devastated.**"*

*But thanks to Good Neighbors, I was able to feed my children and begin discussing plans for redevelopment and relocation. I found hope when I thought I had none left. I'm thankful to God for this opportunity—and to Good Neighbors for giving us hope."*



## Manila, Philippines

In August 2024, Typhoon Gaemi—locally known as Carina—intensified by the Southwest Monsoon, caused widespread destruction in the Philippines, particularly in Metro Manila. The storm affected 299,344 families (1,319,467 individuals), leading to severe flooding and the destruction of homes, property, and livelihoods. The aftermath created complex challenges, including food insecurity and health risks.

In response, Good Neighbors USA, in collaboration with the Good Neighbors Global Partnership Center and GN Philippines, carried out emergency relief efforts to support affected communities during this critical time.



## “I am Koryoin”

**Koryoin** or **Koryo people** refers to people who fled from the Korean Peninsula to various regions of the Soviet Union during the late Joseon dynasty period and the Japanese colonial period. Neither Korean nor Russian, the Koryoin community are *stateless* and left helpless without access to basic necessities.

In order to break free from the cycle of inherited poverty and achieve a stable life, the Koryoin community requires comprehensive support. In response, Good Neighbors USA has launched a campaign to provide livelihood support, housing assistance, and education support. Through this initiative, we aim to empower the Koryoin community by offering resources that promote sustainable development and improved living conditions, enabling families to thrive and create brighter futures for their children.

# Domestic Program

Since opening in 2017, the Good Neighbors USA Women and Children Shelter in Los Angeles has provided critical support for survivors of domestic violence, particularly women and children at risk of homelessness.

In 2024, the shelter served 75 individuals—52 adults and 23 children—offering safety, stability, and a path toward independence. Originally designed to support 25 families, the shelter ultimately assisted 44 families throughout the year, reflecting the growing need for safe and supportive housing in the community.

We provided comprehensive, individualized case management services, including:

- Emergency and transitional housing support
- Assistance with medical care, mental health referrals, and trauma therapy
- Legal aid (restraining orders, immigration support, and T-visa applications)
- Help obtaining vital documents (e.g., ID)
- Transportation services and incentives
- Long-term housing placement and rental assistance






